

Apprenticeship BEAUTY THERAPY: NVQ 2

Level 2

Length 1 Year

Entry Requirements

By interview. This course is for students who have completed NVQ Level 1, school leavers with 3 grade C GCSEs, or above, or mature students.

Description

You will learn how to identify skin types and choose suitable facial products, cover all aspects of manicure, pedicures and specialist treatments, learn to apply makeup for different occasions, eyelash perming and tinting and waxing techniques, all within a professional working salon.

How you are Assessed

Continuous throughout the course in the form of projects, assignments, case studies, coursework and an external assessment in some units.

Progression Routes

You could progress to the Advanced Apprenticeship at Level 3 or the Diploma in Holistic Therapies. You could also consider a Management Qualification.

Additional Information

You will have the opportunity of practising your skills in a professional salon within the college in addition to gathering your own workplace evidence in order to compile a portfolio for your NVQ assessment. During the course you will have the opportunity to participate in additional activities and qualifications such as: visiting the Clothes Show and Beauty exhibitions, learn Calfen Ear Piercing, Fake Bake Tanning, Body Wrapping, Tooth Fairy and Tooth Gems etc.

Because of the professional nature of this course it is necessary for you to purchase your own kit and uniform before the start of the course. You will be advised how and when you can do this at interview.

Key Skills/Functional Skills – you will be expected to achieve these at the appropriate level if you do not have evidence of GCSE Grade C in relevant subjects, obtained within the last 5 years.

Employment rights and responsibilities (ERR): A short, separate assignment is required to evidence the apprentice's understanding of their employment rights and responsibilities.

A separate technical certificate is not required to meet the requirements of the Apprenticeship at level 2
