

Advanced Apprenticeship BEAUTY THERAPY: NVQ 3

Entry Requirements

NVQ Level 2 in Beauty Therapy or equivalent and interview.

Description

This course is for students who have gained a Level 2 in Beauty Therapy or therapists who require specialist beauty qualifications and ultimately aspire to a management position.

On this course you will learn how to assess an individual client, then provide specific treatments. You will also be able to carry out anti-cellulite treatments, hydrating and non-surgical face lifts, muscle toning and electrolysis and many other advanced treatments.

About the Course

To gain the full NVQ certificate, you must prove your competence in the following units:

- * Contribute to maintaining and improving services to clients
- * Contribute to the financial effectiveness of the business
- * Contribute to the maintenance of health, safety and security in the salon
- * Indian Head Massage
- * Improve body condition using electro therapy
- * Provide head and body massage treatments
- * Improve facial condition using electro-therapy
- * Remove hair using diathermy and blend galvanic epilation methods
- * Anatomy and Physiology

How you are Assessed

Continuous throughout the course in the form of projects, assignments, case studies, coursework and an external assessment in some units.

Progression Routes

You may like to consider progression into Higher Education or a Management programme.

Additional Information

You will have the opportunity of practising your skills in a professional salon within the college in addition to gathering your own workplace evidence in order to compile a portfolio for your NVQ assessment.

During the course you will have the opportunity to participate in additional activities and qualifications such as: visiting exhibitions, Caflen Ear Piercing, Fake Bake Tanning, Body Wrapping etc.

Because of the professional nature of this course it is necessary for you to purchase your own kit and uniform before the start of the course. You will be advised how and when you can do this at interview.

Key Skills/Functional Skills – you will be expected to achieve these at the appropriate level if you do not have evidence of GCSE Grade C in relevant subjects, obtained within the last 5 years.

Employment rights and responsibilities (ERR): A short, separate assignment is required to evidence the apprentice's understanding of their employment rights and responsibilities.

A separate technical certificate is not required to meet the requirements of the Advanced Apprenticeship at level 3
