Entry Requirements

At least three GCSE's at grade D or above to include Maths and English plus a satisfactory College assessment and interview. You must also be able to demonstrate an aptitude for practical skills.

Description

This course is for those wishing to gain a basic skill in carpentry to support their apprenticeship in the construction industry.

About the Course

This course specialises in developing wood trade practical skills involving site work, carpentry and joinery. You will also study Health and Safety, Handling and Using Materials, Working Relationships and Use of Power Tools.

How you are Assessed

Assessment will be carried out throughout the course by assignments, end of unit tests, end of course examination and practical tasks.

You will be expected to build portfolios of evidence and you will need to show good compliance to Health and Safety practices throughout the course.

Progression Routes

Successful completion of this course can lead to an Advanced Apprenticeship in Wood Trades.

Additional Information

You will need to equip yourself with protective footwear and overalls before you start the course.

Key Skills/Functional Skills – you will be expected to achieve these at the appropriate level if you do not have evidence of GCSE Grade C in relevant subjects, obtained within the last 5 years.

Employment rights and responsibilities (ERR): A short, separate assignment is required to evidence the apprentice's understanding of their employment rights and responsibilities.
