Initial assessment and interview.

Description

This course is for anyone who wishes to train in the hair industry. It covers the practical skills you will need as a professional stylist such as cutting, styling, colouring, perming, dressing and finishing all types of hair.

About the Course

Units:

- * Ensure your own actions reduce risks to Health & Safety
- * Fulfil salon reception duties
- * Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- * Advise and consult with clients
- * Shampoo and condition hair and scalp
- * Cut hair using basic techniques
- * Style, dress and finish hair using basic techniques
- * Change hair colour using basic techniques
- * Perm and neutralise hair using basic techniques

How you are Assessed

Assessment of this course is on a continuous basis, with each student building a portfolio showing evidence of their understanding. You will also have to complete two assignments and 14 written tests

Progression Routes

Progression to an Advanced Apprenticeship at NVQ Level 3, subject to interview.

Additional Information

Uniform/Kit: Because of the professional nature of this course, it is necessary for you to purchase, before the course starts, your own uniform and kit from the college. Price available on application.

Key Skills/Functional Skills – you will be expected to achieve these at the appropriate level if you do not have evidence of GCSE Grade C in relevant subjects, obtained within the last 5 years.

A separate technical certificate is not required to meet the requirements of the Apprenticeship at level 2.
