

Tuc Diploma In Occupational Health And Safety

Course Overview

This course will develop your understanding of health and safety principles and practice. This course will run over 36 weeks.

Duration: This course will run over 36 weeks part of the course will be distance learning. Please be aware that dates for college sessions may vary from term to term. Term timetables will be sent to students on application.

1st term start 21st September 2010 - 6 sessions at the college 6 distance learning modules

2nd term start 4th January 2011 6 sessions at the college 6 distance learning modules

3rd term start 3rd May 2011 - 6 sessions at the college 6 distance learning modules

Who the course is for: Established Health and Safety Union Representatives.

Course Content

This course will develop your understanding of health and safety principles and practice and includes modules on: health and safety organisation; health and safety law; health, safety and welfare in the environment; research, communication and problem solving. The TUC Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety is accredited at OCN Level 3 to meet the academic requirement for IOSH Technician Safety Practitioner membership.

Entry Requirements

You must be aged over 19 and an elected Trade Union Health and Safety Representative who has attended the TUC stage 1 and 2 Health and Safety Representative's courses or their equivalent.

Learning Methods

You will learn in our well resourced Trade Union Education Centre. A range of learning methods will be used including tutor-led sessions, workshops, portfolio building and tutorial support.

Assessment Methods

You will be assessed in various ways, including:

- Building a portfolio
- Group work
- Projects
